

## GCE ADVANCED LEVEL SUBJECT RESULTS

There were 153 students in Year 13 in 2012/2013.

Grades A to E are passes at 'A' Level, grade U is unclassified.

The pass rate at 'A' Level was 99.8%.

The average number of 'A' Levels gained per candidate was 3.6.

43% of entries passed at grades A and A\*; 76% of entries were passed at grades A\*, A and B; 91% were grades A\* to C.

The average UCAS points score per candidate was 413 (based on grade A\*=140, A=120 pts., B=100, etc.)

70% of our Y13 students each gained at least one grade A\*/A pass, 41% each gained two or more grade A\*/A passes including nine who each gained four or more A\*/A grades.



## AS LEVEL SUBJECT RESULTS

There were 165 students in Year 12 in 2012/2013, most took five subjects including General Studies.

The pass rate at 'AS' Level was 98%.

68% of entries were at grades A and B; 88% were grades A to C.

72% of students each gained at least one grade A pass, 53% each gained two or more grade A passes including almost a quarter who each gained four or five A grades.

Every student passed at least six GCSEs at Grade C and above (including English Language and Mathematics).

The average number of passes at grade C and above per student was 10.4.

79% of all entries gained grades A and A\*.

A hundred students each gained five or more passes at grades A and A\*, 64 each gained ten or more passes all at grades A and A\*.

The average points score (based on A\*=58, A=52, B=46, etc.) was 548, which is equivalent to over ten A grades or nine A\* grades per student.
