



Year 12 Politics Trip to the Palace of Westminster Tuesday, May 22nd 2018

Our annual Year 12 trip to the Palace of Westminster takes place on Tuesday, May 22nd. It includes a parliamentary tour where we sit in on debates on both houses, a workshop led by a member of the education service and the possibility, depending on his availability, of a meeting with Richard Graham, M.P. for Gloucester. We travel by train and underground, meeting at Gloucester station at 10.30am with collection from the station at 21.45.

The trip also includes a period of remote supervision from 17.00-19.00 in the Oxford Street area, when students will have an opportunity to find an evening meal and perhaps do some shopping. Students will be asked to form groups of a minimum of two and will be given my mobile number so that I am contactable during this period. The reason for this is that the first return train, for which our off-peak tickets are valid, leaves Paddington at 19.48.

In order for the trip to take place, it must be self-financing, and so we invite you to make a contribution of **£17.00*** to cover the costs of travel, which Parliament is also subsidising.

Students do not need to wear school uniform.

If you choose not to pay via the online facility, please include cash or a cheque with the consent form, in an envelope marked with your child's name and form, and the name of the trip.
