YEAR 11: HISTORY GCSE TEXTBOOK PURCHASE

Your son has almost completed the second of four modules leading to his GCSE qualification in History. As part of his GCSE History course in Year 11, your child will be studying *Power and the People: 1170 -1945* and *The Reign of Edward I: 1272-1307*.

It is important for each pupil to have their own copies of the textbooks for these units. They need to have their own copy of the textbook to help them with homework activities and crucially to revise effectively for tests and for their final examination. Unfortunately, our funds no longer stretch to supplying each pupil with all of the different textbooks now required for the new GCSE course, so we are asking parents to purchase the Year 11 textbooks*. No further purchases will need to be made for the History course. We have ordered editions of the textbooks which we would like pupils to purchase directly from school at a combined discounted price of £22.38 for both textbooks.
