## Trip to Sandy Park to watch Gloucester v Exeter Chiefs and England v Australia, Saturday, 24 November 2018

On Saturday 24 November we are running a trip to Sandy Park, the home ground of the Exeter Chiefs, to watch Gloucester play the Chiefs in the Premiership. Looking at the way both sides have started the season, it's going to be a titanic battle and a most entertaining match.

The game kicks off early at 1pm, to allow the crowd to then watch England play Australia on the big screen at the ground, which we are planning to do. The second match at this double-header never fails to excite, so there will be no shortage of high quality rugby on show during the course of the afternoon.

The coaches will leave School at 8am and return at 8:30pm approximately. When we are within an hour of Gloucester, I'll get the boys to ring home, so that pick-ups can be arranged.

The boys should come prepared for all weathers with warm and waterproof clothing, as there will be a short walk from the coach park to the ground, and in November it can get rather chilly even in the mild South West. They will also need to bring a packed lunch and tea or enough money to buy food; we will be stopping en route and there are plenty of food outlets at the ground.

In order for the trip to take place, it must be self-financing, and so we invite you to make a contribution of £34.50 per student\* and £51.50 for adults who would like to join. Payment can be made online (Tucasi) or by cheque (payable to Sir Thomas Rich's School) or in cash.
