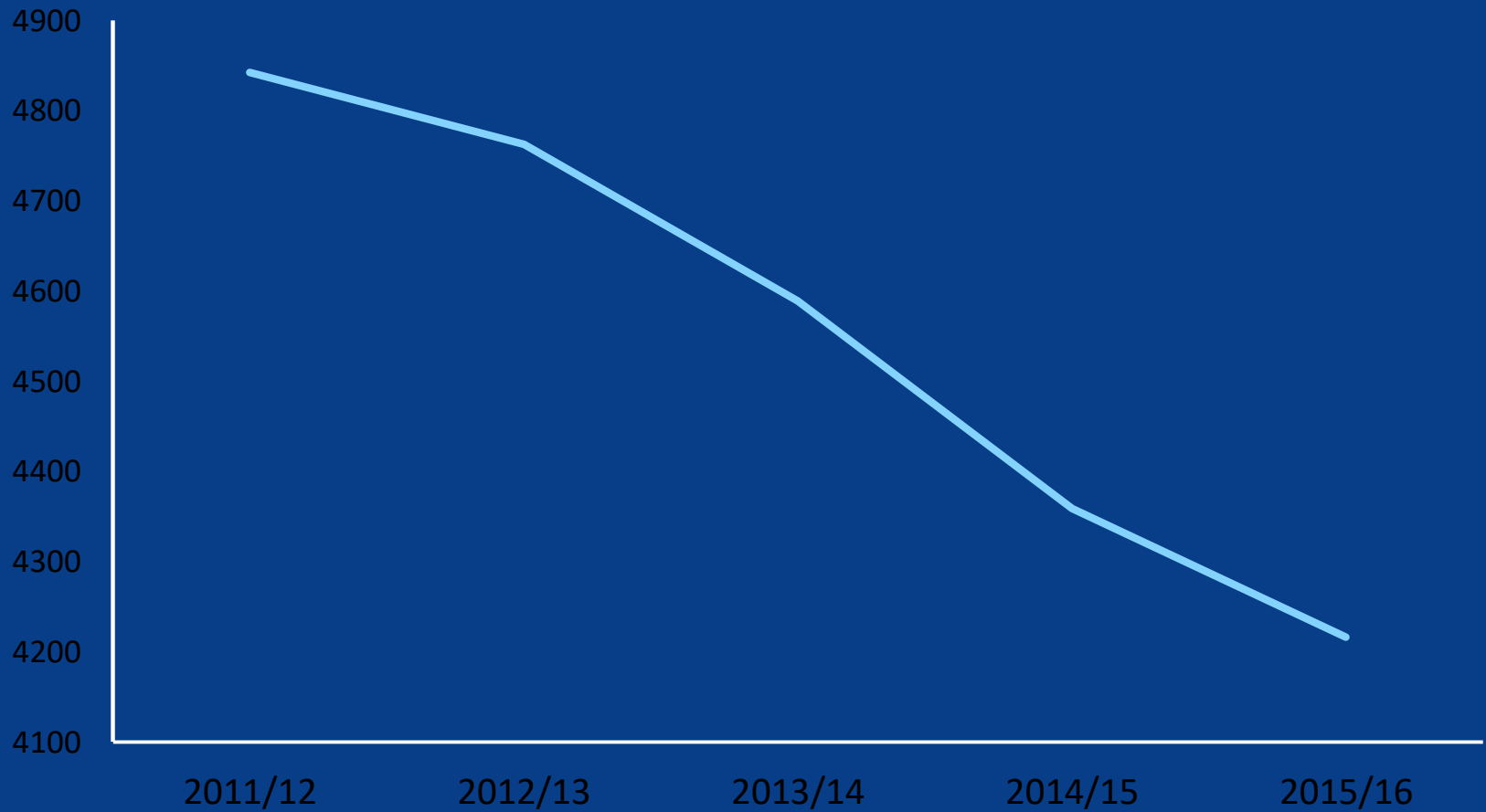

STRS Approach to Learning Grades

Mostly (Mo or 2)	... perseveres with tasks regardless of difficulty.

Sometimes (So or 3)	... uses homework as an opportunity to consolidate understanding and apply new and existing knowledge and skills.
	... works productively on their own and with peers.
	... organised and ready to learn, arriving to lessons on time and with the correct equipment.
Rarely (Ra or 4)	... has a conscientious approach to meeting deadlines and catches up any work missed due to absence from lessons.
	... aware of the impact of behaviour on their own learning and that of others, respecting the Classroom Code of Conduct.
