***Spanish Exchange - Joint Trip to Bristol,
Thursday, 21 March 2019***

The second leg of the exchange is approaching fast and I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your support so far.

A key feature of our exchange programmes is always a joint day trip, with the students from both The High School for Girls, Sir Thomas Rich's and their exchange partners.

This year we have arranged a trip to the **Bristol** for Thursday 21st March, where the pupils will visit *We the Curious*, science centre, Millennium Square. There will be the opportunity for students and their partners to **BUY lunch at Zaza Bazaar for £11.00 per head for the all-you-can-eat buffet**. Thereafter we will be driven to Cabot's Circus for the students to have time to explore the shopping centre. Staff will be present all day, but students will be allowed to explore areas, defined by the teaching staff, in groups of no fewer than four.

We will travel by coach and will **leave School at 09:00 and return at 17:30**

The boys should come prepared for all weathers with warm and waterproof clothing and do not need to wear school uniform on this day. They will also need to bring a packed lunch or enough money to buy food.

The cost of the trip is included in the overall exchange costs so there is **nothing further to pay**. Please complete and return the consent form by Monday 11 March.
