Y12 Biology Trip – Museum of Natural History, Oxford - Thursday 16th May 2019

The Biology Department has organised a trip for Y12 Biology students to The Museum of Natural History in Oxford.

We are aiming to cover work on Evolution and Classification at the museum. The students will have a tour of the museum and a member of the museum will show them some of the relevant artefacts. They will need to complete some sections in their Evolution and Classification workbooks during their visit. They should also have time to visit the Pitt Rivers Museum attached to The Museum of Natural History.

We ask you to make a voluntary contribution* of £10.50 towards the cost of the trip.

If you choose not to pay via the online facility, please include cash or a cheque with the consent form, in an envelope marked with your child's name and form, and the name of the trip to the Finance Office** **by Friday 3rd May 2019** (making cheques payable to 'Sir Thomas Rich's School').

It is vital to return the consent form even if paying online - without this, students will not be able to participate.

We are planning to leave school by coach at **8:45 am** and return for approximately **3:30 pm**. Students should wear school uniform and must bring a packed lunch, pen and pencil and their Evolution and Classification workbook.
