

Year 12 Politics Trip to the Palace of Westminster

The trip will take place on Thursday 14th November. We plan to travel by train and tube, meeting at Gloucester Railway station at 10.30 to return to the station at 21.45. Students do not need to wear school uniform, but should dress appropriately for a visit to parliament. There is no need for students to attend school that morning and students are expected to make their own way to the station.

We aim to start at the Supreme Court for a 30-minute tour at 2.00, followed by a political tour of Parliament, a workshop led by a member of the Palace's education department and a meeting with either Richard Graham M.P. or one of his staff. Following this, the group will be given an hour's free time in the Oxford Street area because the first off-peak return train does not leave Paddington until 19.48. During this time, the students will be supervised remotely and will be given my mobile phone number in case of emergency.

In order for the trip to take place, it must be self-financing, and so we invite you to make a contribution of £14* to cover the costs of travel. If your child is in receipt of the Pupil Premium grant, please contact <u>rmd@strs.org.uk</u>, as we may be able to offer support with the cost of this trip.

I would be grateful if you could return the consent slip to the Finance Office** by November 4th at the latest. If you choose not to pay via the online facility, please include cash or a cheque with the consent form, in an envelope marked with your child's name and form, and the name of the trip.
