From the Headmaster

I don't intend to write to parents every week, but I have decided to this week as the self-isolation period for those testing positive for COVID-19 has changed again, which may have an impact on those students currently self-isolating.

Changes to the self-isolation period

From Monday 17 January, those who are self-isolating with COVID-19 will have the option to end their isolation period after five full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day five and day six providing they do not have a temperature. For example, if they test negative on the morning of day five and the morning of day six, they can return to school immediately on day six.

The first test must be taken no earlier than day five of the self-isolation period, and the second must be taken the following day. All test results should be reported to NHS Test and Trace and via Parent Gateway.

If the result of either of their tests is positive, they should continue to self-isolate until they get negative results from two LFD tests on consecutive days or until they have completed 10 full days of self-isolation, whichever is earliest. Anyone who is unable to take LFD tests or anyone who continues to have a temperature will need to complete the full 10-day period of self-isolation.


