School leadership

In many ways this is one of the most difficult emails I have had to write as Headmaster of Sir Thomas Rich's. I have been offered the post as Head Master of Bishop Wordsworth's in Salisbury and I have accepted the position. This post will commence in September 2024, and I will leave Rich's in August 2024.

This has been a difficult decision to make. Whilst I am very much looking forward to my new role, I will be immensely sad to leave STRS. I joined Rich's as Deputy Head in September 2007 and then was appointed as Head in 2013. 17 years is a long time in the life of any school, and I would not leave unless I felt the school was in good shape. All organisations benefit from new ideas and approaches, and schools are no exception. I have long been a proponent of the importance of a fresh pair of eyes, and this is as true for my role as it is for any job in the school.

There will, of course, be a chance to reflect later in the year, but I wish at this stage to thank parents (past and present) trustees and pupils for their steadfast support over the years. Sir Thomas Rich's is a special place and there is not one day that goes by without me remembering that I have been enormously privileged to have helped lead this precious community.

I have discussed arrangements with our Chair of Trustees and I know the appointment of my successor is in safe hands.

There is much to be done in the remainder of this year and I will endeavour to redouble my efforts in order to ensure the School continues to develop.
