I would like to invite all pupils in Year 11 to attend a revision session before each of the English Literature exams. The aim will be to go over some key concepts, how to structure an answer and to live model my response to some new sample questions. I will also give them some final top tips for how to use the time before the exam in the most effective way, and I will provide some resources to help with this.

The first session will be on Friday 8 May during period 5 in the drama theatre 14:20-15:20. English Literature Paper 1 GCSE exam is then on the following Monday. I will focus on Macbeth and Jekyll and Hyde.

The second session will be on Monday 18 May during period 5 in the drama theatre 14:20-15:20. English Literature Paper 2 GCSE exam is the following morning. I will focus on Animal Farm, the poetry anthology and unseen poetry.

This is certainly not compulsory, but it will definitely be a beneficial use of time for all pupils. Unfortunately, some will be in other exams, which is unavoidable at this point. If anyone cannot attend and would like to have a 1:1 with me, I am happy for them to arrange that with me.
