



Year 10 Parents' Consultation Evening

Dear Parents

On **Tuesday 19 May** we shall be holding our Year 10 Parents' Consultation Evening.

Making Appointments

This will be a virtual Parents' Consultation Evening using the video meeting facility within the TES (SchoolCloud) Parents' Evening service. You may have used the system for previous Parents' Consultation Evenings, and to access the system, you will need to visit <https://strs.schoolcloud.co.uk/> or use the link from the *Parents* page of the School's website. You will not be able to make any appointments for the Parents' Evening until the evening goes live **Tuesday 12 May at 7.30 pm**. To log into the system, you will only need your name and email address, along with the name and date of birth of your child. Ensure you enter the details accurately, as the system may be somewhat particular, and the details need to be entered exactly as we hold them on our school systems.

Appointments can be booked up until midnight on Monday 18 May.

Arrangements for the Evening

For the evening itself, you will need a device with a camera that is web-enabled and an internet connection in order to participate. For instructions and requirements for joining video appointments, please see [how to attend appointments over video call](#)

The evening runs from **4.00 pm** until **8.00 pm**. Each appointment is five or ten minutes in length, and the system automatically limits appointments to the time slot allocated and does not allow the appointment to be extended; therefore, we ask you to prioritise the issues you wish to discuss within this time limit.

Pupil Attendance

We would normally advise that your child should aim to attend the video appointments with you, as they are clearly central to the discussions about their progress during Year 10. *However, we are also aware that the Short Course RS GCSE takes place the following day, and some pupils may wish to use their time on this evening to review the revision they have done for this paper. We will leave it to you and your son to decide whether their attendance is beneficial on this occasion. There will be no appointments available for RS teachers as these were held in the previous stand-alone Parents' Evening.*
