Dear Parents

Please find below specific details from The Army. In terms of Friday please ensure where possible your child is at Okehampton Camp at **2pm** with kit prepared for inspection. Once we have a suitable pitch we will notify you where this is on the map and where we are based for the students to find us. Please ensure this form is sent back to me completed as soon as possible along with a completed consent link for the Army for your child. Please complete the consent form below. If your child is a reserve please can you also fill in the reserve consent form. These forms need to be sent back to me as soon as possible. All students **MUST** watch the safety briefing, as soon as they have done this they must email me to confirm they have watched it.

### Parents/Guardians – Important Information for Ten Tors

Please read this notice carefully and take it with you if visiting Ten Tors.

Your child has been selected to participate in the Army's Ten Tors Event on Dartmoor over the weekend **08-10 May 2026**. They have completed training under my direction (Chloe Rigby-Smith and Ocean Rock) and are well prepared for their Challenge.

Myself and Mrs Atkinson are responsible for the conduct and welfare of all participants over the weekend, from arrival until the start of their Challenge, and from hand-back by the Army until your child is returned to you. We are also responsible for the conduct of everyone associated with our Team, including supporters. To assist us with this, please adhere closely to the guidance in this notice.

Mrs Atkinson will set up camp on **08 May**. Your child will move to the camp on **Friday 08 May**, where they will undergo final checks of all equipment and their planned routes. **Students must bring expedition food for the Friday evening and Saturday morning as well as for the Challenge itself.**

Friends and family are welcome to visit Okehampton Camp at any time during the Event.

### Car Parking Passes (as discuss previously)

- Limited availability, including a limited number of disabled passes (a valid Blue Badge is required and must be

displayed).

- Sold online only, in advance. Vehicles without a valid pass will be turned away.
- Tickets go on sale at 08:00 on Monday 27 April via: [www.tentors.org.uk/parking](http://www.tentors.org.uk/parking)
- Cost: £8 per day for Saturday and £8 per day for Sunday (no weekend passes available).
- Passes must be **printed in colour** and clearly displayed on the vehicle dashboard.
- Spectators attending on both days must purchase separate tickets for each day.
- The increased parking fee covers professional traffic management and an ANPR system.
- All tickets require a Vehicle Registration Number (VRN) at the time of purchase. If the VRN is unknown or changes before the Event, vehicles will be directed to a vehicle-check car park where proof of payment must be shown.

## Event Timings

### Ten Tors Challenge

Starts on Saturday at 0700 hrs, weather permitting, with a parachute display. The Challenge finishes on Sunday, with the earliest teams arriving from approximately 0830 hrs. All teams must finish by 1700 hrs.

You can monitor likely arrival times via <http://www.tentors.org.uk/>. Please note that updates may be delayed, and this should not be a cause for concern. On Sunday, the Public Information (PINFO) building will display team locations at one-minute intervals once teams have passed their final staffed location. To follow a team's progress, you will need the Team Route Code, which is: **Route- T ID Number- O**.

Please follow all safety instructions contained in the Event Brochure, which you will receive upon arrival at the public car park. The Event Guide will also be available on the Ten Tors website homepage from **08 May**.

### Important Notes Before Departing for Dartmoor

- Flying drones is illegal on Dartmoor under National Park Byelaws and is strictly forbidden during Ten Tors due to the serious safety risks they pose, particularly to helicopters.
- Dogs are not permitted to stay overnight in car parks or on the campsite, except when in transit. Dogs may be taken into public areas of Okehampton Camp and onto the Moor, provided they are insured, kept on a lead, and owners dispose of waste in the bins provided.
- If you visit the campsite, please report to Mrs Atkinson so that we can brief you on any additional safety rules.

Participants must complete their Challenge unaided, as anything that may be construed as assistance could result in disqualification. The sole exception is the final 500 metres, where you are welcome to accompany and encourage them. In the event of any incident (including individual or team withdrawal, medical evacuation, or event cancellation), the Army will pass relevant information directly to me and to other Team Managers as required. I will inform you by telephone of any incident affecting your child. Please direct any concerns to me and not to the Army. As a safeguarding measure, the Army will only hand over participants to the registered Team Manager or Deputy Team Manager, and not directly to parents or carers.

Please ensure that I have your current mobile telephone number, should I need to contact you.
