

## GCE ADVANCED LEVEL SUBJECT RESULTS

There were 195 students in Year 13 in 2016/2017.

Grades A to E are passes at 'A' Level, grade U is unclassified.

The pass rate at 'A' Level was 99.7%.

The average number of 'A' Levels gained per candidate was 3.2.

43%\* of entries passed at grades A and A\*; 73%\* of entries were passed at grades A\*, A and B; 91%\* were grades A\* to C (\* excluding General Studies)

The average UCAS points score per candidate was 372 (based on grade A\*=140, A=120 pts., B=100, etc.)

70% of our Y13 students each gained at least one grade A\*/A pass, 46% each gained two or more grade A\*/A passes including 38 students who each gained three or more A\*/A grades.



## AS LEVEL SUBJECT RESULTS

In A Level subjects which have already been reformed to decouple AS Level from A Level, students did not take an AS Level. 150 students took AS Levels in at least one subject.

Grades A to E are passes at 'AS' Level and there is no A\* grade.

## GCSE SUBJECT RESULTS

There were 124 pupils in Year 11 in 2016/17. In Mathematics, English Language and English Literature pupils sat reformed GCSE specifications which awarded the new 9 to 1 grades. All other subjects were awarded A\* to G grades.

101 students each gained five or more passes at grades A and A\* or equivalent, 35 each gained ten or more passes all at grades A and A\*.
