The average number of ' A ' Levels gained per candidate was 3.1 .
$39 \%$ of entries passed at grades $A$ and $A^{*} ; 74 \%$ * of entries were passed at grades $A^{*}, A$ and $B ; 90 \%$ were grades $\mathrm{A}^{*}$ to C

The average UCAS tariff score per candidate was 125 (based on grade $A^{*}=56, A=48$ pts., $B=40$, etc.)
$61 \%$ of our Y 13 students each gained at least one grade $\mathrm{A}^{*} / \mathrm{A}$ pass, $41 \%$ each gained two or more grade $A^{*} / A$ passes including 32 students who each gained three or more $A^{*} / A$ grades.


## GCSE SUBJECT RESULTS

There were 124 pupils in Year 11 in 2018/19. Pupils sat reformed GCSE specifications which awarded 9 to 1 grades.

105 students each gained five or more passes at grades 9 to 7 or equivalent, 39 each gained ten or more passes all at grades 9 to $7.48 \%$ of all grades were at the top two grades ( 8 or 9 ). $100 \%$ of students gained five or GCSE passes at grades 4 or above with $98 \%$ of these gaining passes at this level in English and Mathematics. On average, students gained over 10 GCSE passes at grade 4 or above.
