The pass rate at A Level was 99.9%.

The average number of A Levels gained per candidate was 3.2.

50% of entries passed at grades A and A*; 80%* of entries were passed at grades A*, A and B;
94% were grades A* to C.

The average UCAS tariff score per candidate was 134 (based on grade A*=56, A=48 pts., B=40, etc.)

74% of our Y13 students each gained at least one grade A*/A pass, 50% each gained two or more grade A*/A passes including 73 students who each gained three or more A*/A grades.
